Three Siblings...


Kept together by you

In November 2015, a few weeks before Thanksgiving, Paul and Suzanne received a call from Southern Christian Services regarding a set of three siblings. After meeting the children and prayerful consideration, they agreed to foster the siblings in hope of adoption. When the children arrived to their new home, they were all on medication and performing poorly in school. Paul and Suzanne immediately enrolled the children in

a school that met their special needs and offered extra help. They exposed the children to new experiences such as traveling, the arts, bonding with extended family, and extracurricular sporting activities, all while maintaining connections with their biological family.

Paul, Suzanne, and the three siblings officially became a family of five on November 10, 2016! We are proud to report that the children are thriving, no longer prescribed medication, and on honor roll! We are grateful to Paul and Suzanne for caring, nurturing and providing stability to their children.

We are also very grateful to each of you for supporting Southern Christian Services! Because of you, families are able to adopt children from foster care at little to no cost. Your support allows us to keep siblings together and provide loving and nurturing homes for all children in our care.



Therapeutic group homes provide family style living for children and youth who are unable to remain in their own homes because of abuse, neglect, serious behavioral, and/or emotional challenges.

Therapeutic Foster Care

Licensed TFC homes provide a temporary family for children and youth who are unable to remain in their own homes because of abuse, neglect, serious behavioral and/or emotional challenges.



Kate lived at one of our group homes for a couple of years. It was time for her to leave state custody, but she had nowhere to go. The homeless shelter was her only option.

Kate had a job, but was not ready to be on her own. She had no family support. If we kept her in our group home there would be no reimbursement for her care. Because of your support, we did not hesitate. Not one bit!

Kate stayed in our residential program three more weeks. During this critical time, she received services from our Independent Living Department. The staff found her a place to live and an educational program so she could learn a trade.

Now, Kate's receiving support from an entire new group of people to show her the way as she begins living independently.




